 - Junior fair reports that the senior fair/ junior fair mixer will be cancelled this year due to date conflicts.
 - Dalton Bush reported that the royalty luncheon will be on Sunday the 21st. He stated they are reusing decorations to help with their budget. They are asking for \$200 for remaining expenses, Von informed them that it is already in the budget.
 - Junior fair board is asking permission to move their trailer for stock the trailer to inside the gates.
 - Joy Sharp asked senior fair board for somewhere to start storing stock the trailer items as the kids are getting donations from schools currently. She also reported that quality assurance is due May 1st and we are currently at 63% completion with around 170 kids that still need to complete. All 3 in person QA's have been completed, about 212 kids attended between the 3 which is up by 37 kids from last year.

 - The final thing discussed for junior fair board was for the outhouse races, . Senior fair board decided to strongly discourage the use of bicycle frames for this year. Come next year this will become a rule
